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## **SRR's 2.5 million safe hours earn second consecutive URS President's Safety Award**

AIKEN, S.C. (January 27, 2011) – Savannah River Remediation (SRR) LLC has been awarded its second URS President's Safety Award.

This marks the second time SRR has achieved the award, which is administered and distributed by SRR's parent company URS, San Francisco, CA.

The award acknowledges SRR having reached 2.5 million hours without a lost work day case. SRR is located at the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) Savannah River Site (SRS) near Aiken, S.C. Dave Olson, SRR's Operations and Deputy Project Manager, along with Jim Wilson, the SRR Field Safety and Health Manager, were lauded with a plaque commemorating the SRR achievement.

Brad Giles, URS Vice President of Energy and Construction, presented Olson with the award, noting, "Dave Olson's and SRR's continued safety commitment" while continuously demonstrating safety as a priority among management and SRR employees alike.

Patricia Allen, SRR's ESH&QA Contractor Assurance manager, was impressed with the awards, adding, "It is a significant accomplishment for the project."

The awards were presented at the monthly SRR Executive Safety Quality Board meeting, which includes representatives from DOE, Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board and SRR senior management.

SRS is owned by DOE. SRR is the SRS Liquid Waste contractor, and is composed of personnel from a team of companies led by URS with partners Bechtel National, CH2M Hill and Babcock & Wilcox. Critical subcontractors for the contract are AREVA, Energy Solutions and URS Safety Management Solutions.
