## **Supplemental Analysis Available For Transportation of Depleted Uranium Hexafluoride (DUF) for Conversion to Depleted Uranium Oxide (DUO)**

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has prepared a Supplemental Analysis (SA) in accordance with 40 CFR 1502.9 © and 10 CFR 1021.314, for the proposal to transport cylinders of DUF from the Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plant (PGDP) in Piketon, Ohio to the AREVA-NP Fuel Fabrication Facility at Richland, Washington, and subsequent transport of cylinders containing DUO from Richland to the Savannah River Site. Based on this analysis, DOE's proposed action does not represent substantial changes that are relevant to environmental concerns for DUF-DUO transportation actions evaluated in the Surplus Plutonium Disposition (SPD) Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and there are no new circumstances or information relevant to environmental concerns that bear on the proposed action or its impacts that would warrant additional NEPA Analysis.

Furthermore, DOE has previously decided to prepare DUO from DUF to support MOX fuel fabrication and is not changing that decision. Therefore no changes to the record of decision is required.
